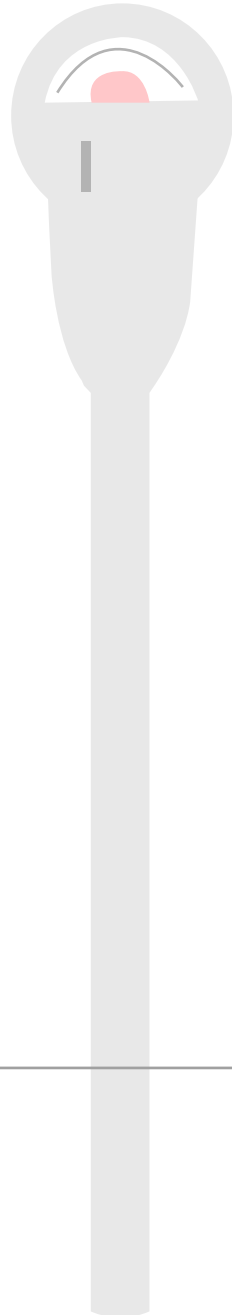

Inspire - Downtown residents, visitors, workers, and passersby of the inherent potential within people and urban spaces

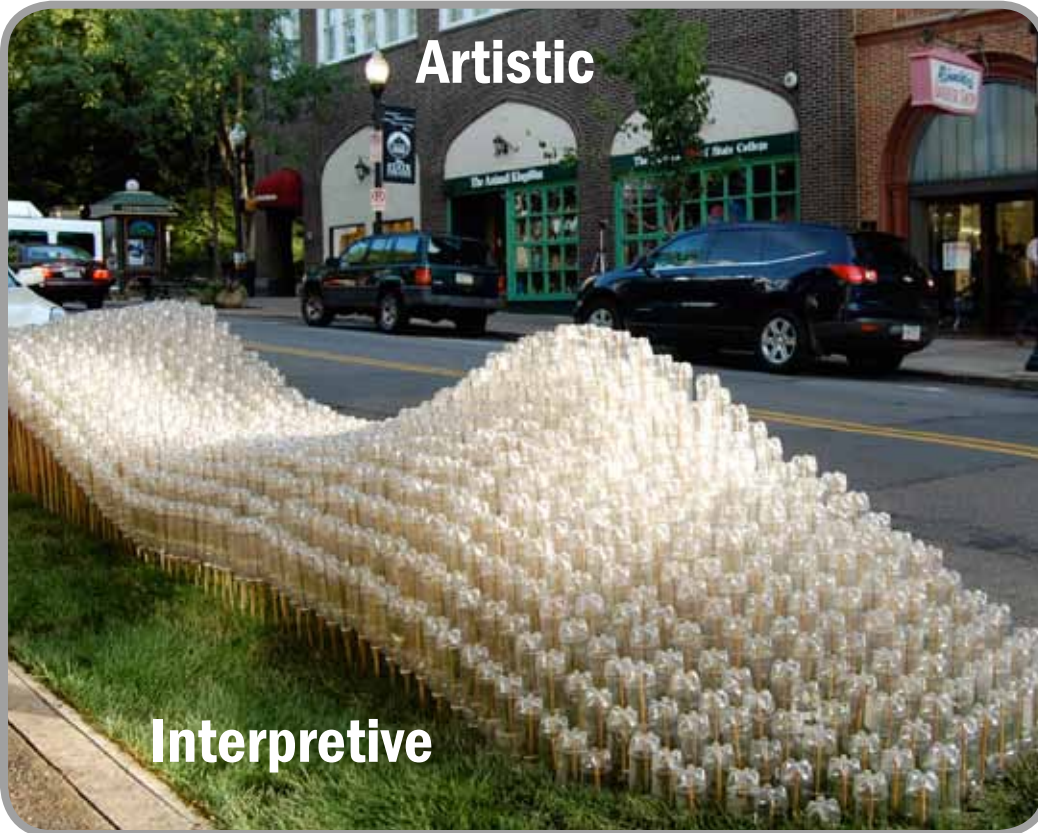
Involve - Allow local organizations the opportunity to reach out and further push Lexington's ever improving landscape

Monday September 17th

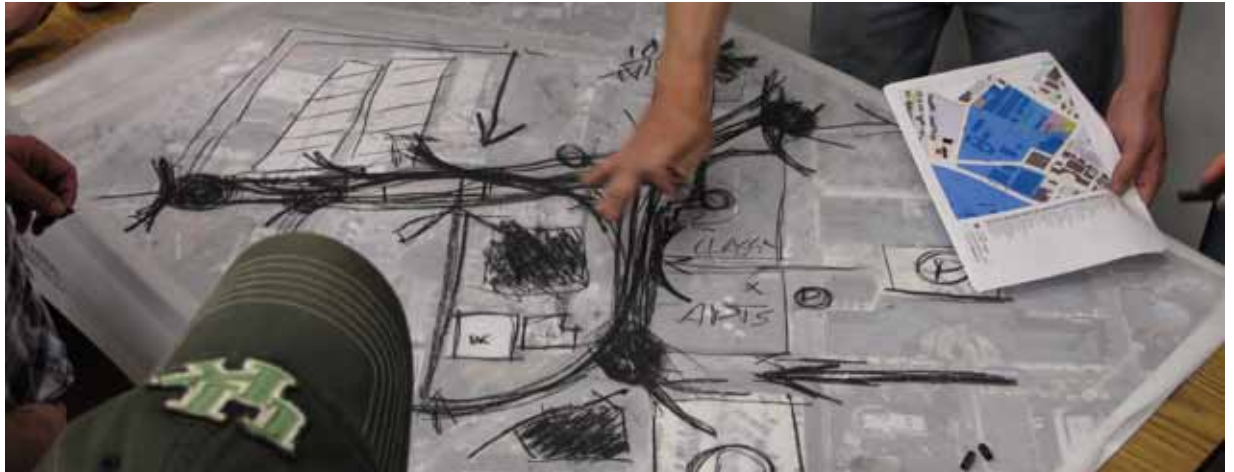
- Design Charette

Wednesday September 19th

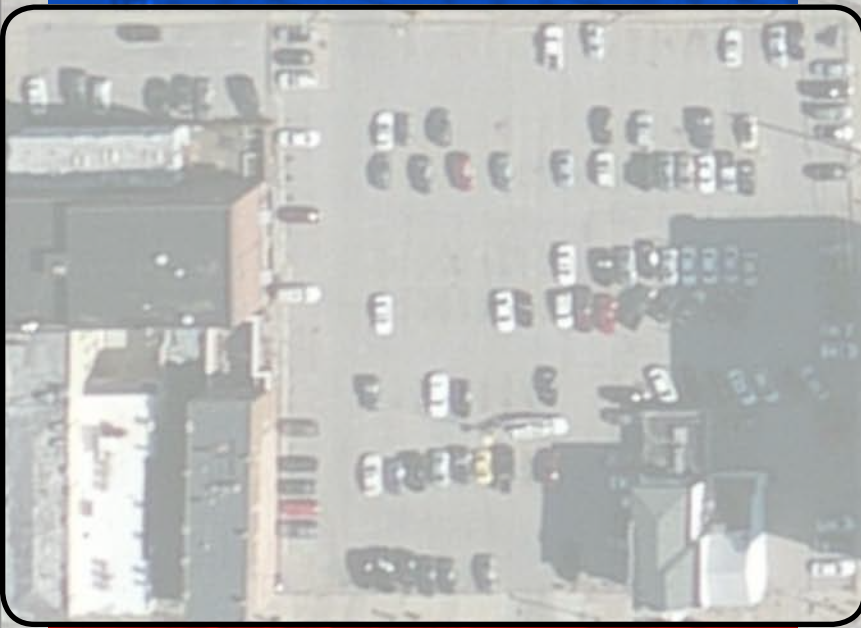
- Work day to finalize designs, acquire materials, prefabrication of design elements, package the design process drawings.

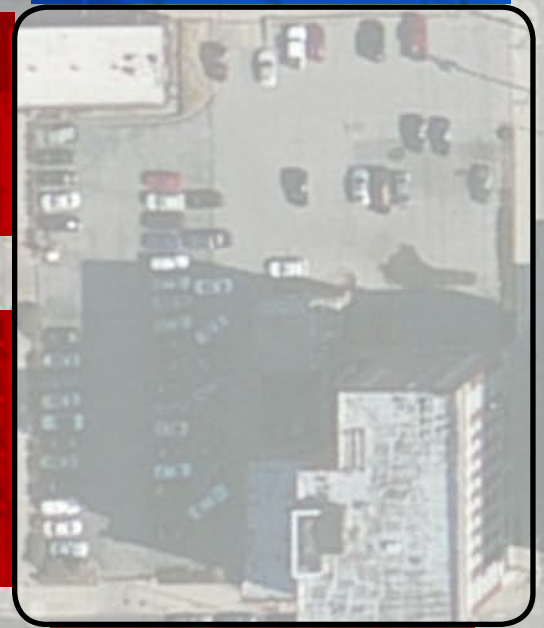

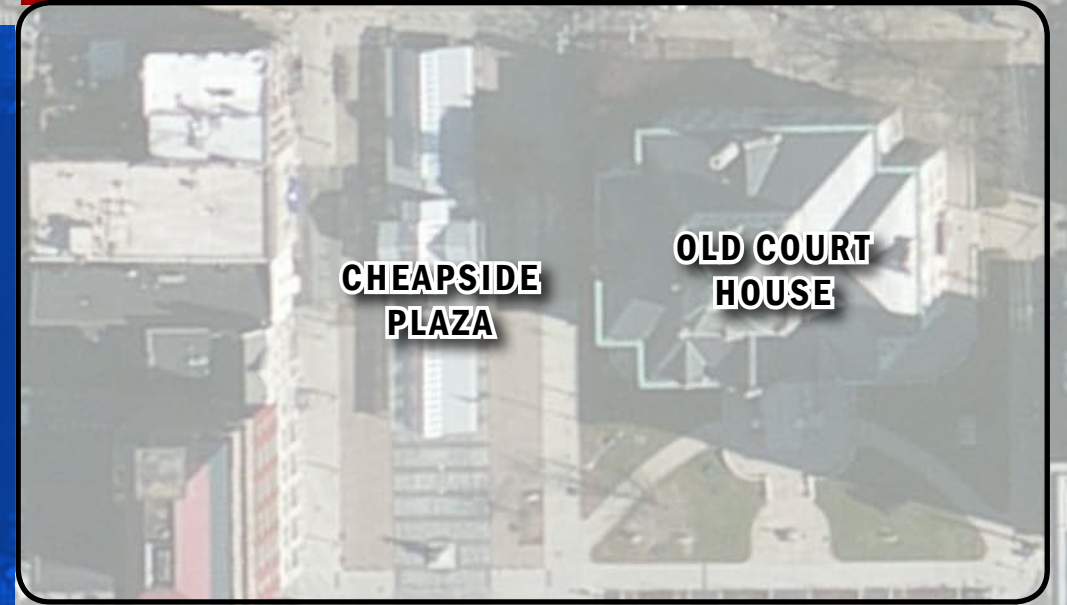

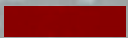

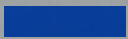
